

AZ STATE & MARICOPA COUNTY IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

SUBJECT TO CHANGE

Please note: Your child's immunization records are not required until after the HCLC Lottery.

The starred boxes below show all immunizations currently required for school/childcare attendance by Arizona State Law (A.R.S. §15-872) or Maricopa County Health Department. By law, your child will **not** be allowed to register for school/childcare until either a record of these immunizations or an acceptable exemption statement is submitted.

Please note that 4 items, (Tdap, Hep A, HIB, & MCV4), are age or grade specific.

TO COMPLY WITH ARIZONA LAW, YOU MUST DO ONE OF THE FOLLOWING BEFORE YOUR STUDENT CAN BE REGISTERED:

1. If your child has already received the necessary immunizations, bring his or her immunization record to school. The record must show the child's name, date of birth, the date that all doses were received, and the name of the physician or health agency that administered the vaccine. Your present physician can write or stamp "Other Provider" or "Transcribed Record" in any unsigned vaccinations that were not given in their office.
2. If your child has not received the necessary immunizations, take your child's **immunization record** to your physician or local health department to get required immunizations and/or records.
3. Exemptions to immunization requirements are available. If immunizations are against your religious or personal beliefs, you must complete, sign and return an exemption statement to the school/child care center. If any immunization(s) cannot be given for medical reasons, or there is laboratory evidence of immunity, you must submit a medical exemption signed by a physician. A copy of the lab results must be submitted along with the exemption form.
